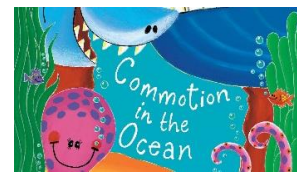
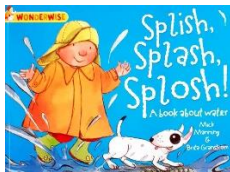


Nursery Curriculum- Summer Term 2

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we embark on the final half term in Nursery, we would like to share the key topics and themes that your children will be exploring over the coming weeks.

Our new topic for the term is 'Splish, Splash, Splosh'. The books we will be looking at will include: Water, The Seaside, Ocean Life.



Maths

During our maths lessons we will focus on measurement by exploring weight and capacity. We will use balance scales to show the difference between heavier and lighter objects. We will also use positional language in our everyday vocabulary.

Literacy

We will recall events from the stories we read and discuss the key elements e.g. the beginning, middle and end of the story.

Communication & Language

We will engage in imaginative play based on the stories we are reading. We will listen carefully to others when taking part in 'circle time' and ask questions to gain further understanding.

Physical Development

We will start to prepare for our sports day by mastering basic movements including running, throwing and balancing. For some, this will be their first sports day!

Personal, Social & Emotional Development (PSED)

We follow the Jigsaw Scheme of Work and our topic this half term is 'Changing Me'. We will talk about growing up and how we have changed since birth. We will discuss skills that we have gained now and compare these to when we were younger.

Understanding the World

We will explore floating and sinking and use comparative language such as 'heavier' and 'lighter'. We will carry out our own science experiments.

Expressive Arts & Design

We will continue to improve our creative skills by using a range of tools to mark make including paint brushes and marbles. We will learn water, weather and seaside related songs and rhymes.
