*We learned all about the different jobs that Fire Fighters do. We found out about the protective clothes and safety equipment fire fighters use.*

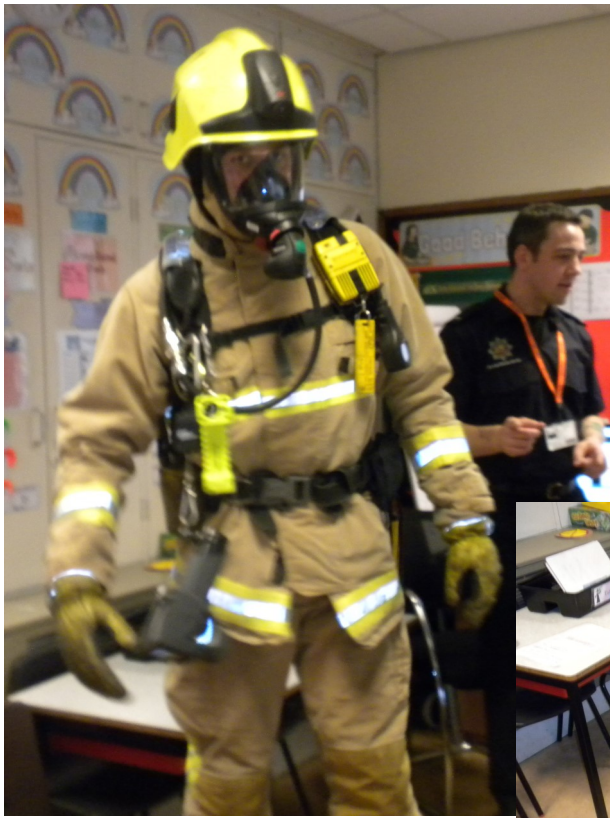
*We learned some rhymes to help us stay safe.*
