



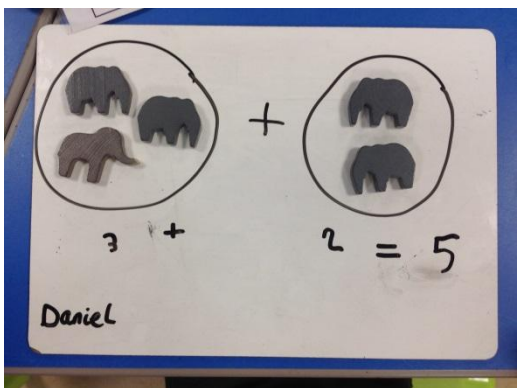
In Gold Class we have been learning about 'Opposites'.
