We will continue daily focused phonics sessions, further developing the children's knowledge of sounds in words and matching sounds to letters. Children will be encouraged to use their phonic knowledge to read and write words and sentences. We will continue to read and write high frequency and tricky words and be able to sort real and nonsense words. Children will be challenged to read and write two syllable words and begin to write short stories. We will enjoy a range of fiction and non-fiction books. How you can help - Continue to share books daily. Practise writing full names and correct letter formation. Complete home learning activities including phonics activities that are sent home.

Maths



Our learning this half term will cover aspects of Number and also Shape, Space and Measure. In Number we will be finding one more and one less and adding and subtracting one digit numbers. We will explore doubling and halving and be solving number problems. In Shape, Space and Measure we will learn about and use the correct vocabulary associated with time, measure and money. We will explore, create patterns and build with two and three-dimensional shapes.

How you can help - Encourage your child to recognise, order and write numbers to 20 and beyond. Challenge your child to solve simple number problems that involve adding, subtracting, doubling and halving. Complete home learning activities.
