The will be learning to negotiate space when playing, racing and chasing. They will be developing their throwing, catching and kicking skills, along with continuing to travel with confidence under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment. ## Maths



We will continue to develop our number recognition through investigating numbers inside and outside of the classroom. We will be learning 1 more and 1 less than a given number and adding two groups of numbers together. We will be using vocabulary linked to addition and subtraction and learn about 2D and 3D shapes. We will be measuring using blocks, jumps, rulers, tape measures and child initiated techniques. We look forwards to playing mathematical games with your child

How you can help - Counting, writing numbers to 10 and beyond, exploring numbers in the environment and working with numbers through your child's play.

Topic work - topics this term will include:
