

Dear Parents and Carers

The children in Years 3 and 4 will be taking part in an educational visit to Roman Verulamium on Wednesday, 10 November 2021. The visit will complete the children's Romans History topic.

An outline of the day:

- The coach will leave school at 9.00am (please ensure your child is on time to school).
- Throughout the day children will have the opportunity to visit Verulamium Museum's galleries, the nearby Roman Amphitheatre and shops as well as take part in a 'handling session' with the Verulamium museum teachers.
- Pupils will stay in their class groups. Miss Mole, Mrs White and Mrs Cobb will support Yellow Class, Mr Steyn, Mr Miah and Ms MacDonald will support Blue Class and Mrs Henshall, Mr O'Grady and Mrs Norris will support Red Class.
- While in Verulamium Museum the classes will also work with the museum's specialists teachers
- I will lead all the groups for the Roman Amphitheatre and shops section of the trip.
- The classes will complete the activities in the order described in the table below.

- Pupils will eat their packed lunch in a local church hall, close to the museum again in class groups. Each child will need to bring a packed lunch to school on the day in a named carrier bag. Please bring a disposable bottle of water to drink at lunchtime (no fizzy drinks please).
- Children will also need a named light-weight raincoat with a hood. This is essential as there
 is a short walk between the museum and the amphitheatre/Roman shops.
- Children should wear full school uniform.















Aims of the Day

- * To consolidate knowledge of life in Roman Britain.
- * To use primary sources to ask and answer relevant historical questions.
- * To experience Roman Mosaics, a Roman amphitheatre, Roman Walls and Roman shops first hand.

The cost of the day including transport, entry and insurance is £15. Parents of children in receipt of the pupil premium grant may use this to fund their child's trip. Please note that although the contributions are a voluntary contribution if we do not receive enough contributions the trip may not be able to go ahead.
