LION KING MUSICAL — 22 June 2022



Holidays in term time


Parents do not have a legal right to take their children out of school in order to go on holiday.


Schools can authorise absence only if:

- there are exceptional circumstances
- the request is made in advance by the parent with whom the child normally lives

If you child is absent from school on a family holiday without authorisation the school will ask the council to serve a Penalty Notice. This Penalty Notice is a fine of £60 which, if not paid within 21 days, rises to £120.



If you think you meet the free school meals eligibility criteria, please call the Local Authority on **0300 300 8306**. When you call to apply for free school meals, please have the following information ready:

- National Insurance numbers and dates of birth for you and your partner
- Dates of birth for your children
- If you receive support from the National Asylum Support Service, your NASS number
