A wonderful time was had by all. Please see the range of pictures below to illustrate the day out.

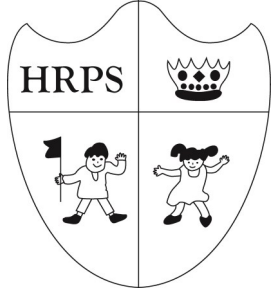

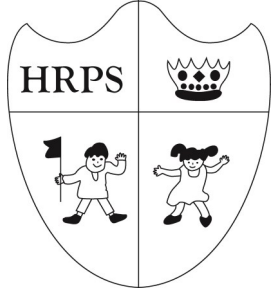

## School entrance at St Michaels Avenue

We are currently reviewing the use of the school car park to ensure vehicles and pedestrians are separated to keep everyone safe. We are therefore implementing the following:

- Cones will be placed marking a clear pedestrian area in time for when children arrive and leave school. Please can all pedestrians remain to the left hand side of these cones. This keeps the pedestrian areas and school car park separate. Please do not allow your child to walk through the car park area.
- Where possible, parents and carers are encouraged to bring children in via the other 'pedestrian only' routes.
- The car park access gate will be shut from 8:30am onwards with the exception of scheduled visitors.
