

### **Log Cabin Classroom**

I am delighted to share with parents that in partnership with Central Bedfordshire Council we are having a log cabin classroom built on the edge of the school over half term. The lucky first occupants of the new log cabin will be our Platinum Nursery pupils and Mrs Gammon. We are currently buying accessories for the new classroom. Parents of Nursery children in Platinum class should deliver their children to the new classroom in the mornings and also collect them from the log cabin from Tuesday, 8 June 2021. Parents should familiarise themselves with the location of the new classroom on Monday, 7 June 2021. All Platinum children should be delivered to the main Platinum Classroom on the 7 June 2021 while the new classroom furnishings are being finalised.

#### **Ballet**

I am very pleased that there has been a very good uptake for ballet lessons at our school. Christina Marks, our fully qualified imperial ballet teacher, is really looking forward to working with our children next half term. The lessons for this term are now full as is the trip to Sadler's Wells.

Children in both KS1 and Early Years have been enjoying the new, large sandpit. They have been building sandcastles as well as enjoying outdoor opportunities for maths and phonics.



#### **School Dinners**

We continue to be delighted with our new school meal provider HCL. We have received really positive feedback from the children on the variety on offer and the quality of the food. I am pleased that the numbers of children having school meals each day has dramatically increased since HCL have taken over the school meals contract. If your child is still not currently having school meals, please do encourage them to try especially if they are in years Reception, one and two. All children in these year groups are eligible for paid meals under the school Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme. As already stated the governing board would very much prefer all children in years Reception, one and two to benefit from Universal Infant Free School Meals. If you have not activated your School Grid account, please contact the school office who will be able to assist you.
