Attendance

The governors and I, working in partnership with the local council, continue to have very high expectations of school attendance. I therefore need to emphasise again that there should be no holidays taken during term time. Family celebrations should also be planned during the school holidays. We continue to only be able to authorise absence for highly exceptional reasons. The school had to put in place fines for a number of families last year due to families taking unauthorised absences during term time. I would very much like to avoid this moving forward.

To encourage children to attend school as much as possible we are commencing with a number of new incentives for 100%, or near, attendance as well as for high performing classes. There will also be some free trips and events to reward pupils with particularly high attendance.

Attendance Awards for Classes with the highest attendance in specific areas of the school

We will be shortly announcing new attendance awards. These will be named after the youngest members of our royal family. This will support pupils with both attendance and their understanding of our Royal family.

If you think you meet the free school meals eligibility criteria, please call the Local Authority on **0300 300 8306**. When you call to apply for free school meals, please have the following information ready:

- National Insurance numbers and dates of birth for you and your partner
- · Dates of birth for your children
- If you receive support from the National Asylum Support Service, your NASS
