

Spring 1 – Once Upon a Time

7 Areas of Learning:

Personal, Social & Emotional Development (PSED) – We follow the Jigsaw Scheme of work and our topic this half term is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will talk about challenges we may face and how we could overcome these with the help of our friends. We will discuss setting goals and not giving up.

Communication & Language – We will listen carefully and learn traditional tale songs. We will create our own stories as a class, ensuring that everyone contributes their ideas. Also, we will 'hot seat' the characters from our stories to gain a better understanding of how each character might feel.

Physical Development – Our new topic in PE will be Dance. We will be learning and creating simple movement patterns. We will then perform to our friends.

Literacy - In our Literacy lessons we will be writing speech bubbles to explain what the characters in the story might say. We will write our own recipes just like The Little Red Hen!

Maths – During our Maths lessons we will focus on numbers to 10. We will compare numbers and begin to explore addition questions, focusing on number bonds.

Understanding the World – We will learn about different job roles in our world and talk about the occupations of our family members.

Expressive Arts & Design – We will create artwork inspired by the characters from the traditional tales we are reading. We will act out key parts from the stories and think of different ways that the stories might end.

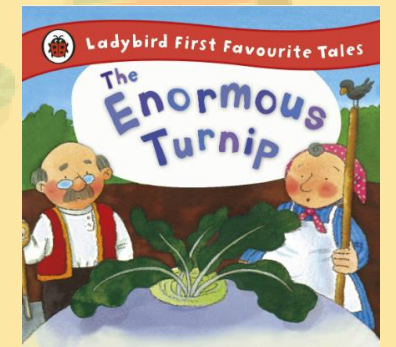
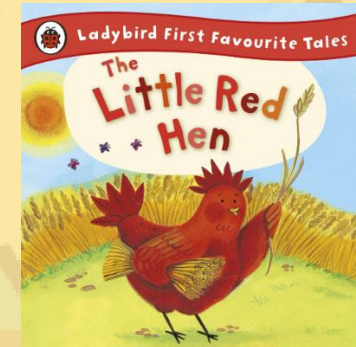
