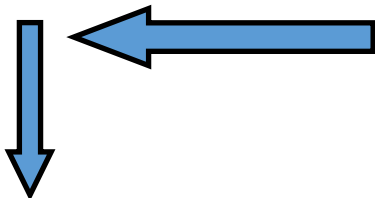

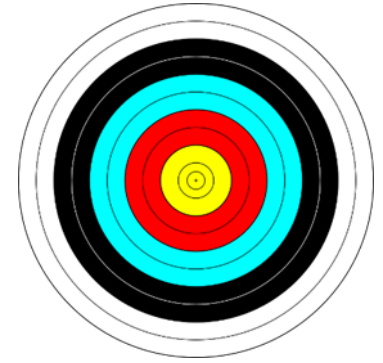

The Attendance Teddy will go to Gold 1 with 99.44% attendance. Fantastic!

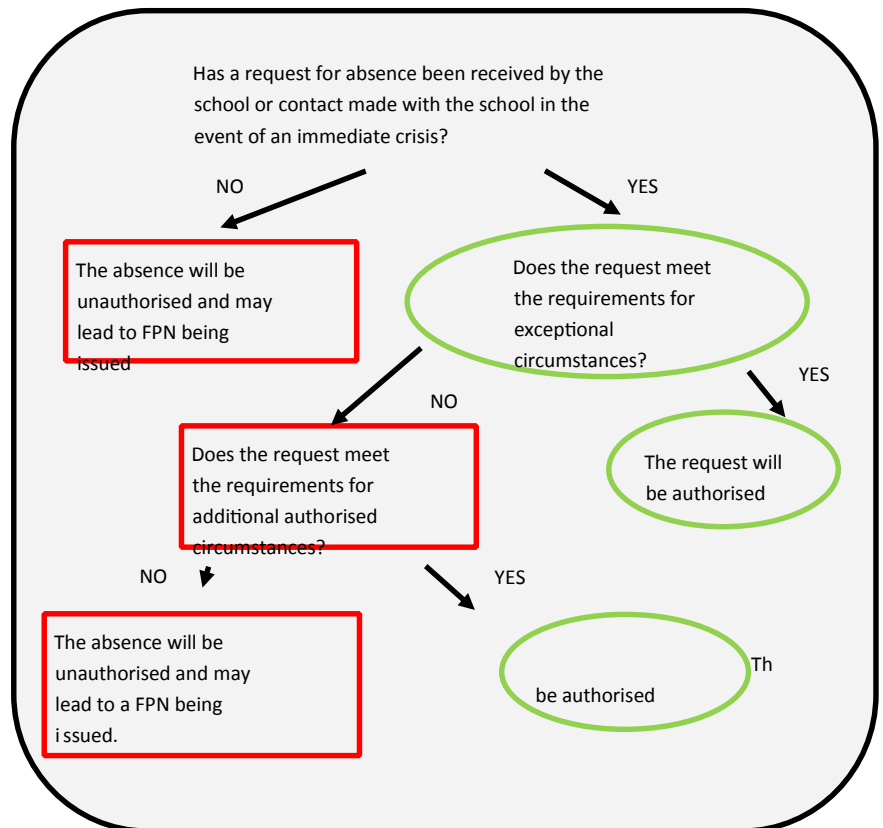


Our school target for attendance is 97%. We are currently below that target.

Exceptional Circumstances:

- Funeral of an immediate family member*
- When a family needs to spend time together because of immediate family member's bereavement, crisis or serious illness.*
- One day of absence could be authorised for an immediate family member's graduation ceremony or passing out parade.*
- One day of absence could be authorised for the wedding of an immediate family member and the invitation has been provided as evidence.*
- Children of service personnel about to go on deployment- permission would be considered as long as the request is accompanied by a letter from the commanding officer.
- Transport was not provided by the Local Authority when it should have been.

* An immediate family member is defined as a parent/legal guardian, sibling, grandparent, aunt, uncle, relative or
